





Distribution of Black Population







Distribution of Asian Population








Primary Language Spoken at Home: Asian Languages

2009 American Community Survey Census Tract Level








Distribution of Hispanic Population



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






Primary Language Spoken at Home: Spanish Language









Ratio of Female to Male Population









Age Distribution: Under 18 Years Old

2010 Census Block Group Level









Age Distribution: 18 to 29 Years Old









Age Distribution: 30 to 49 Years Old









Age Distribution: 50 to 64 Years Old









Age Distribution: Over 65 Years Old


Assessed Value for 1and 2-Family Homes







Assessed Condition for 1- and 2-Family Homes









Average Annual Sales for 1- and 2-Family Homes, 2009 to 2010









Contract Sales for 1and 2-Family Homes, 2009 to 2010









Foreclosures for 1- and 2-Family Homes, 2006 to 2010






